#### **Position Description**

- **Full Stack Developer:** Detail-oriented developer with the ability to create stable, engaging apps for mobile devices and the web. Applicants with a focus on front-end or back-end development will also be considered.



Time commitment is **approximately 8 hours per month** with a flexible schedule that allows for participation in our global team (virtual) meetings.
